

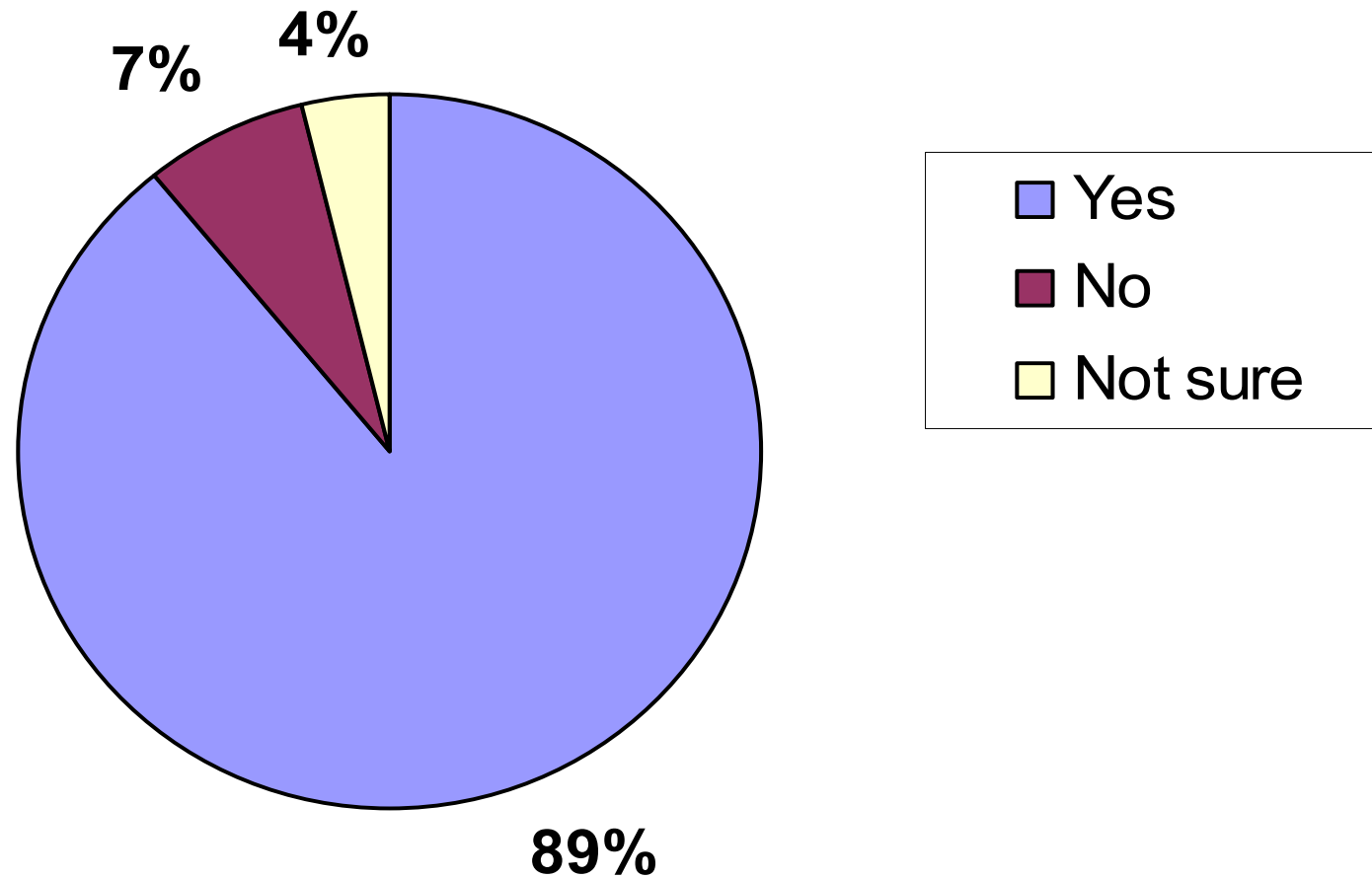

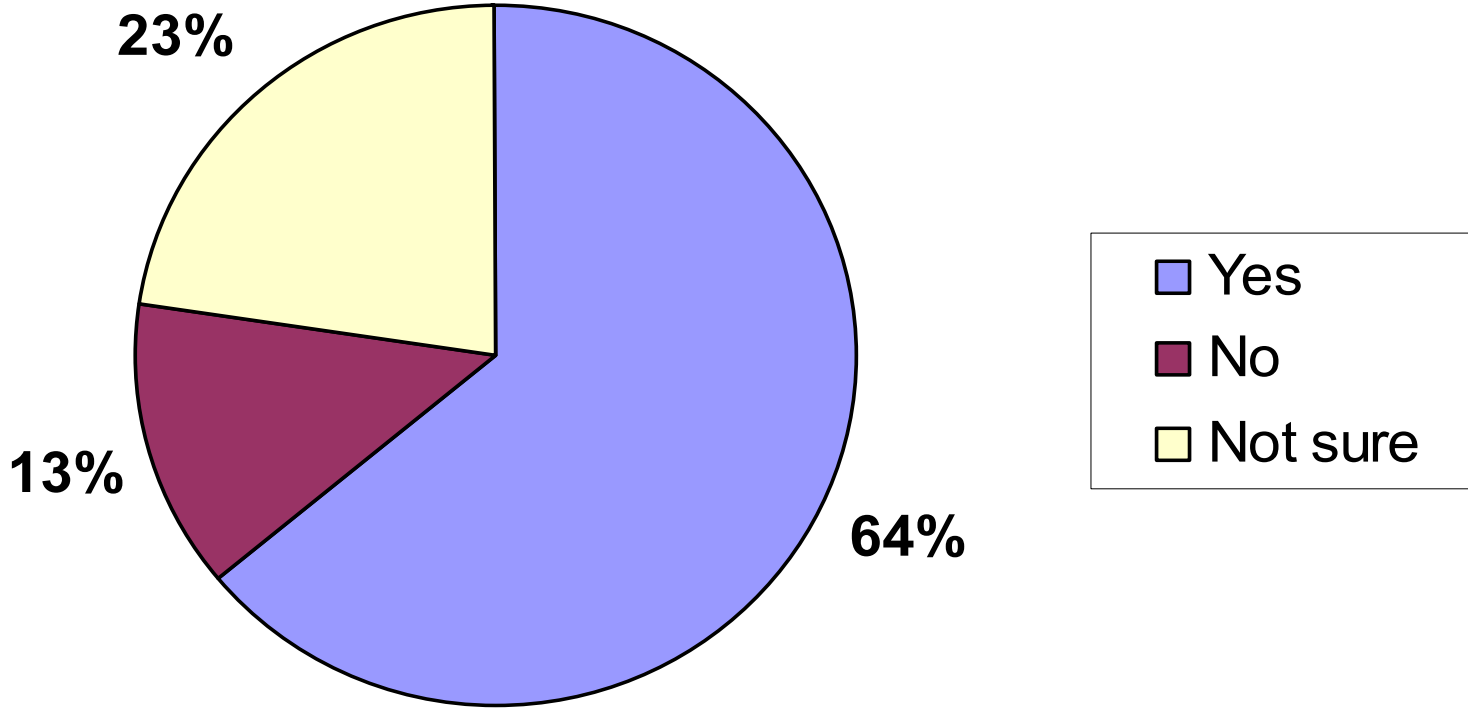

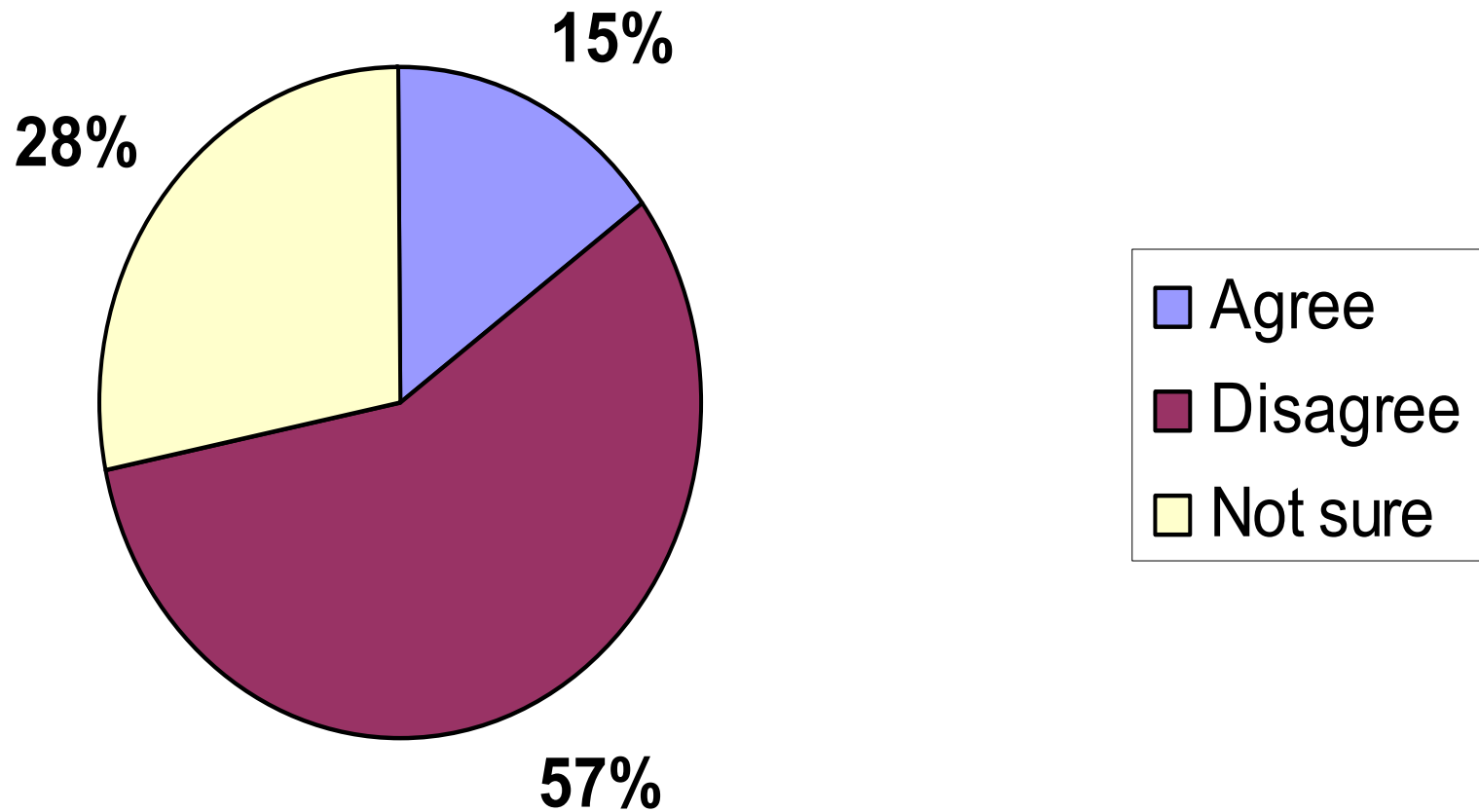
Do you think more information should be made available to Brent residents on how Heathrow expansion will affect them?



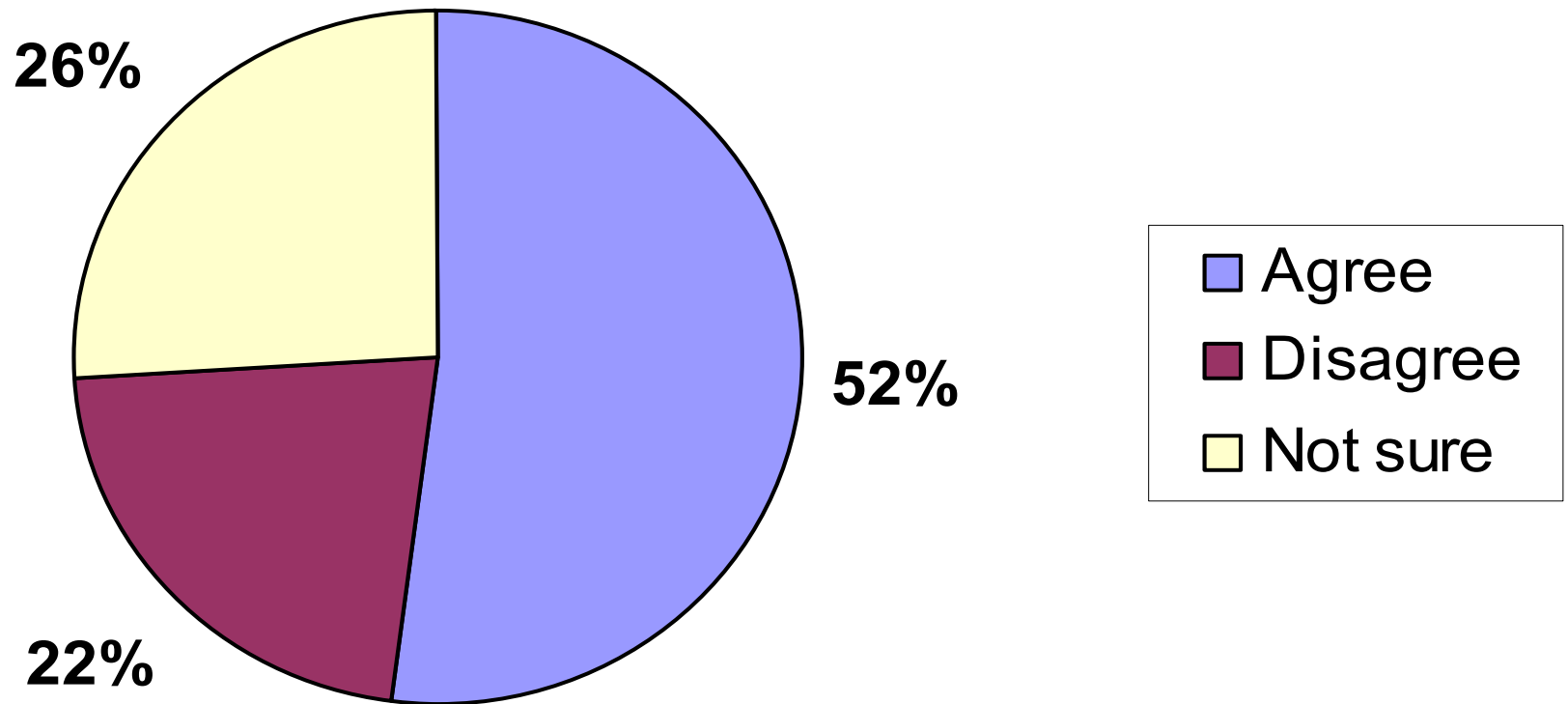
Do you think the government should have organised a public meeting in Brent as part of its Heathrow consultation?



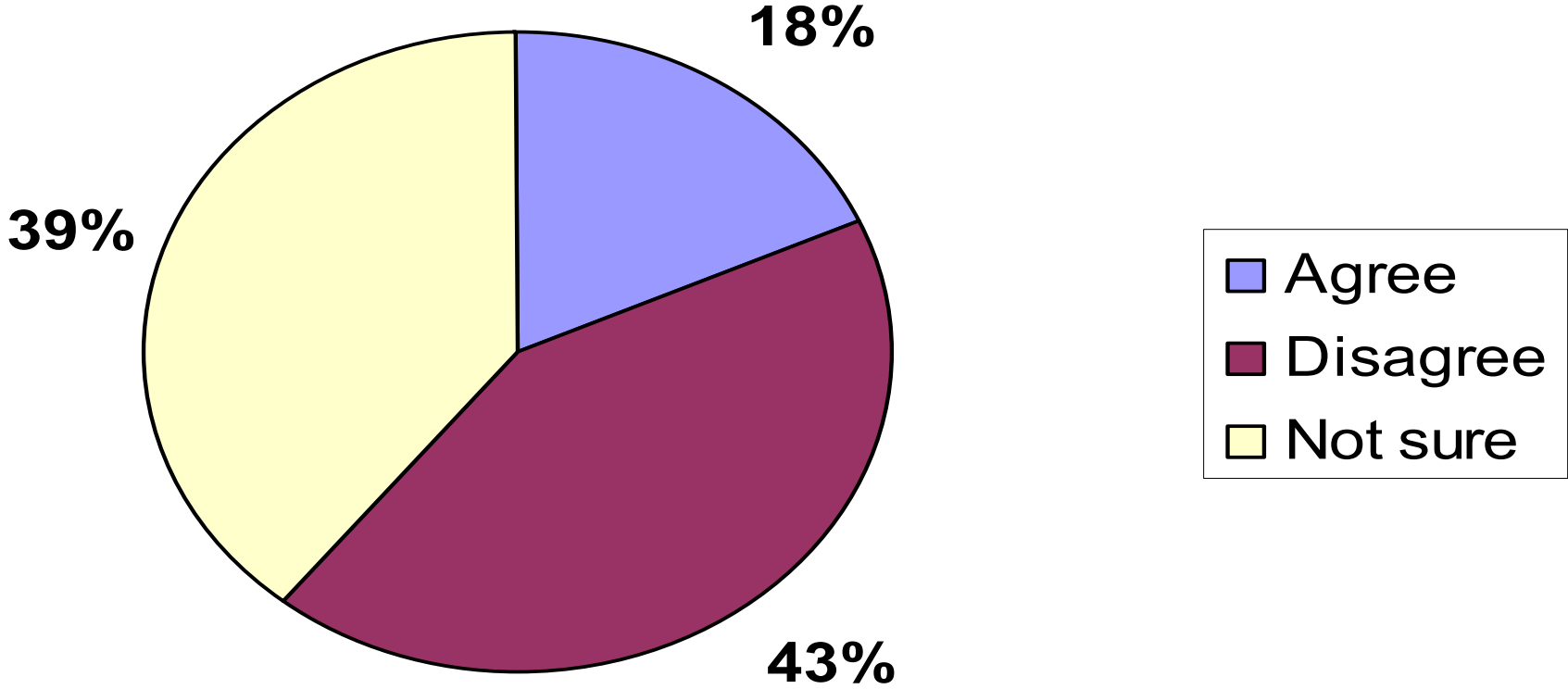
Heathrow expansion will benefit me personally



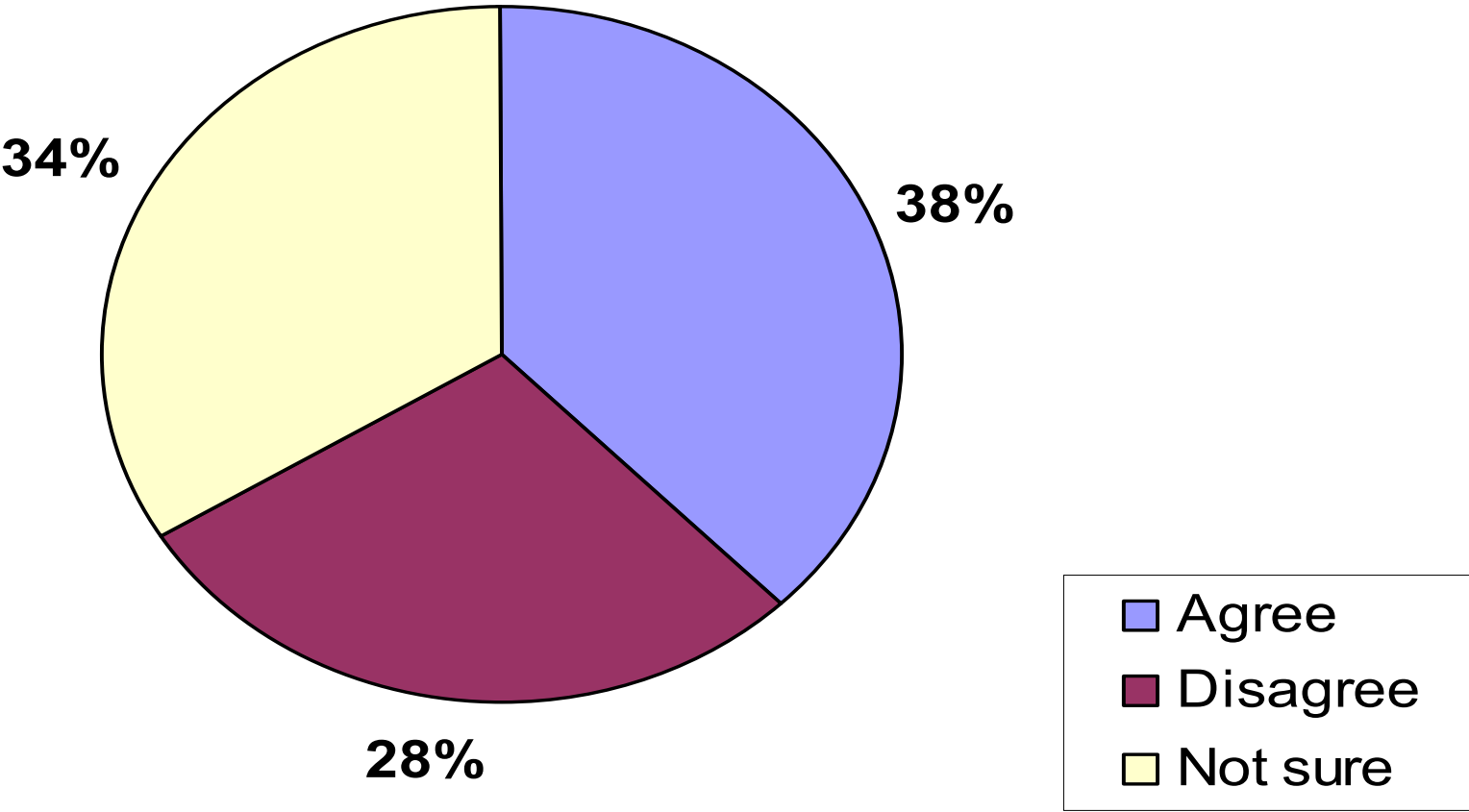
Heathrow expansion will benefit the country economically



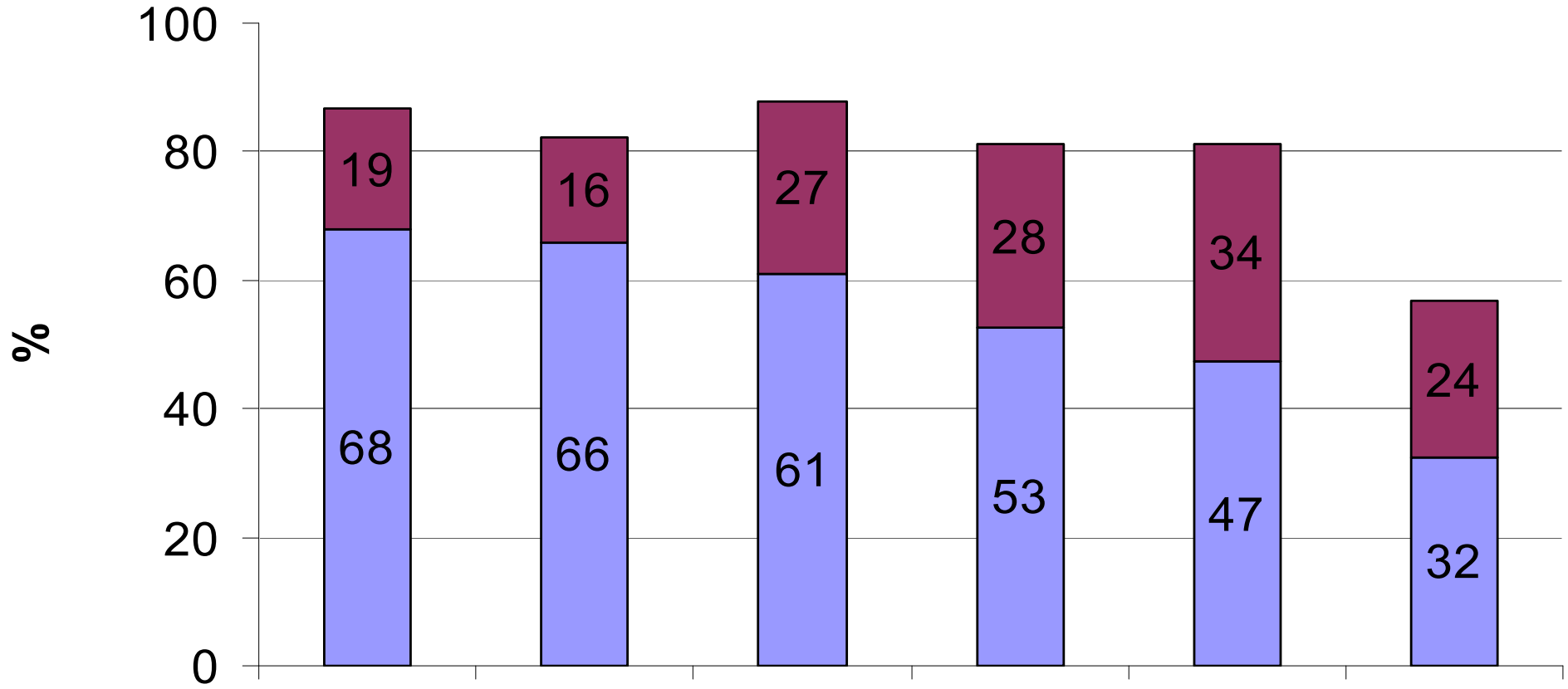
Heathrow expansion will benefit local businesses in Brent

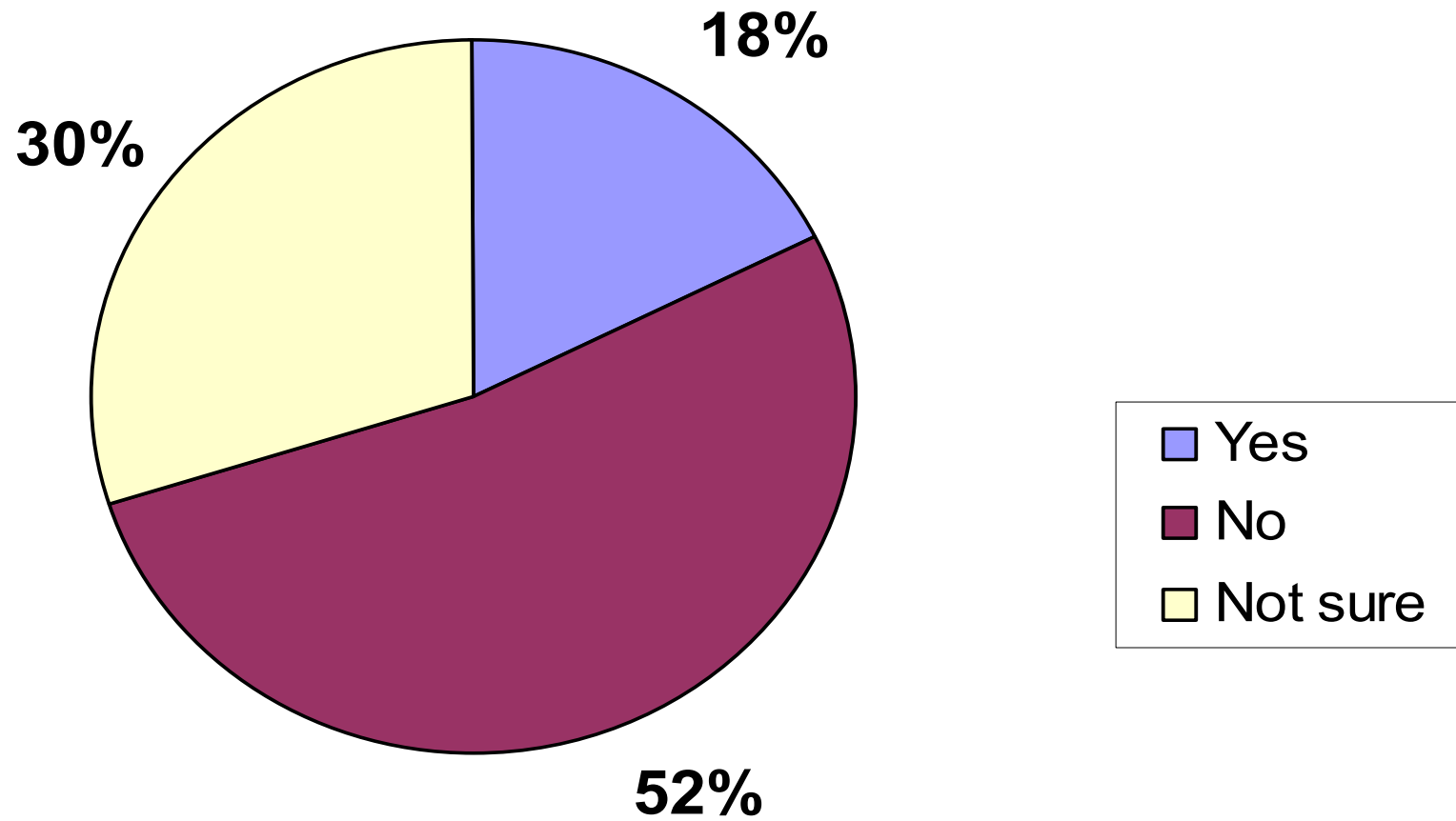
